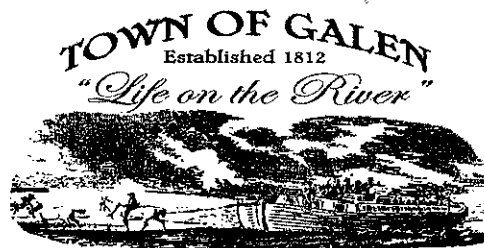

Resolution No. 5-2023 Adoption of Local Law No. 1-2023

Town of Galen Local Law No. 1-2023

A Local Law Amending Local Law No. 1-1990 to a sliding scale with the ceiling being \$24,499.99 pursuant to 467d of Real Property Tax Law.

Section 1, Pursuant to the authority of paragraph 1a (1) of section 467d of Real Property Tax Law./ The Town of Galen, Wayne County, New York elects to adopt the sliding scale as follows;

Annual Income	Partial Tax Exemption
\$16,100.00 or less	50%
\$16,100.00 - \$17,099.99	45%
\$17,100.00 - \$18,099.99	40%
\$18,100.00 - \$19,099.99	35%
\$19,100.00 - \$19,999.99	30%
\$20,000.00 - \$20,899.99	25%
\$20,900.00 - \$21,799.99	20%
\$21,800.00 - \$22,699.99	15%
\$22,700.00 - \$23,599.99	10%
\$23,600.00 - \$24,499.99	5%

Section 2, this law shall become effective immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.

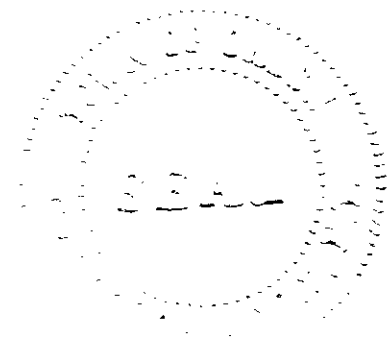
